Highway/Street Priorities

- 1) US 64 Bypass, R-3111 on TIP.
- 2) US 601 to 5-lanes: Just north of I-40 to Angell Rd. The Davie County Thoroughfare Plan calls for 4-lanes. However, I will be sending out a letter to NCDOT Division 9 to see if they recommend 5-lanes.
- 3) Upgrade US 158 into Mocksville.
- 4) Deadmon Rd.: Upgrade to 24-foot facility.
- 5) East Lake Drive: Extend East Lake to Eaton Rd (Mocksville).

Safety Projects

- 1) Put a signal at Valley/Sanford intersection.
- 2) Left turn at US 158 onto Sain Rd. Completed.
- 3) Fork Bixby and Baltimore realignment.
- 4) US 64 east out of Mocksville. Look at possible turn lanes at intersections.

Pedestrian Projects

- 1) Sidewalks on Milling Rd. From Main St for 1 mile. Mocksville.
- 2) Sidewalks on 801 (Cooleemee) commercial district. Approximately 0.5 miles.
- 3) Cooleemee River Park Trails.
- 4) Initial Phase of sidewalks along 601 in commercial areas. Approximately 2.0 – 2.5 miles. Fill in connectors. Mocksville.

Bicycle Projects

- 1) Rich Park Greenway, EB-5005 on TIP (Mocksville).
- 2) Trails in River Park at Cooleemee Falls.
